The Alachua County Sheriff's Office Combined Communications Center is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in six basic areas: organization, direction and authority, human resources, recruitment and selection, training, and operations.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments by calling (352)264-6696 on December 10, 2007, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. Comments will be taken by the assessment team.

Telephone comments are limited to ten (10) minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
