

## OPERATION IDENTIFICATION RECORD

Valuable property should be marked with an electric engraver or any sharp etching tool with your **Florida Driver's License** (FL DL: \_\_\_\_\_). If you are not a driver and are over 18 years of age, any Florida Driver License Issuing Station will issue a Department of Motor Vehicles I.D. Card. It cannot be stressed enough that you should not use your Social Security Number when engraving your items. Federal regulations governing the identity of Social Security restraints make the number next to impossible to trace!

Items which cannot be marked, such as antiques, chains, etc., should be photographed or video taped in color with the owner's identification. A complete description of the article should be written on the back of the photograph take.

**SUGGESTED ITEMS FOR MARKING:** Bicycles, TV's, stereos, cameras, video recorders, appliances, sporting goods, guns, computers, sewing machines, and many other expensive electric equipment. Credit card numbers should also be recorded.
